- ### Tips for Riders
- Signal the operator as your bus approaches.
 - Have fare and ID ready and request a transfer when you board - any ID card MUST be presented to the operator
 - Strollers must be folded before boarding.
 - Operators are unable to help load or unload packages, carts, or strollers.
 - Please use the bike rack. No bikes are allowed inside of the bus.
 - NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS may be brought on board a DMT vehicle. This includes batteries, weapons, or flammable liquids.
 - Pets are not allowed onboard DMT vehicles.
 - Service animals are allowed. Any animals that do not behave appropriately, as a service animal would, will not be allowed on DMT vehicles.
 - Shoes and shirts must be worn.
 - No eating, drinking or smoking is allowed on the bus, per City ordinance.
 - No cannabis, in any form is allowed on City property, including DMT vehicles and transfer facilities.
 - Properly dispose of litter on DMT property and at DMT bus stops.
 - Complaints or compliments may be made by calling (217) 431-0653 or visiting the DMT offices.
 - DMT reserves the right to suspend or refuse service to individuals who fail to comply with the rules.

- ### Bus Stops
- Buses will stop only at locations designated by DMT bus stop signs on Danville, Tilton, and Georgetown routes. Route 10 Danville-Champaign stop locations are listed on the timetable and are shown on the route map.
- ### Dial-A-Ride Service
- This service connects with other routes at :15 and :45 after each hour at the terminal. Call (217) 431-0653 at least one hour in advance to arrange a pickup at any bus stop in the service area. Availability may be limited.

- 1 Grant / Logan
 - 8 Douglas Park (stops south of Main Street)
 - 12 Heights - South Danville
- Saturdays - Service is provided from 8:45 am to 4:45 pm along the following routes:**

 - 13 Tilton
- ### Accessible Services
- Buses are accessible for people using wheelchairs and other mobility devices. For people unable to use regular transit service, paratransit (ADA origin to destination) service is available. Eligibility for the ADA service is determined by guidelines in the Americans with Disabilities Act. Requests for certification should be made to the DMT office. Tickets for ADA rides are available only at the DMT offices. To schedule paratransit rides, certified riders should call (217) 443-2287 the day prior to the date of the requested ride. For ADA rides taken after 7:45 pm weekdays call (217) 431-0653.
