Transfers are free when the fare is paid and must be requested when boarding the bus. Transfers are only valid for a one-way trip and only at designated transfer points. Transfers are only valid for the person who paid the fare.

**PASSES & TICKETS**

DMT office sells day passes or they can be purchased onboard DMT buses.

**Smart Cards**

Available Now! Convenient, fast, easy to use to pay any fare, anywhere, for anyone! Purchase your SmartCard for \$2.50, load the card with cash to use anytime you board the bus. Can be reloaded over and over. SmartCards can be used to pay ANY fare, by ANYone just by telling your driver where you need to go, and who you are paying for.

**SPECIAL FARES - Riders are required to show the bus operator your ID**

**Reduced Fares for Qualified Riders**

Children over 46 inches in height through middle school; all DACC or high school students with valid, school-issued photo ID; people with disabilities, with DMT ID card or CUMTD DASH card designated as NON-ADA; veterans with current Veterans' Administration ID card, or veterans' designation on state ID or driver's license; people with Medicare cards may obtain a reduced-fare DMT ID card from the DMT office.

**Free Fares on Fixed Route Buses for Qualified Riders**

Children at or under 46 inches in height; people aged 65 years and older with DMT ID card or CUMTD DASH card designated as SENIOR; people who qualify for the State Benefits Access Program, with DMT ID card; riders certified for use of ADA paratransit, with DMT paratransit ID card.
